Introduction

The Tahoe Truckee Homeless Action Coalition (TTHAC) is a regional network of local governments, nonprofits, community organizations, and community members working together to improve outcomes for individuals and families experiencing homelessness in the North Tahoe-Truckee region.

Purpose of the 120-Day Community Engagement Plan

The purpose of the 120-day community engagement plan is to build community and neighborhood understanding and gather input on the proposed 1-Year Navigation Center Pilot as it moves forward.

Key Stakeholders

The engagement plan will target key stakeholder groups in the region, including:

- General public
- Neighbors, businesses, and entities near the Navigation Center (with specific focus on the Coldstream and Deerfield areas)
- TTHAC members: Local elected representatives of the TTHAC organizations
